

Cookie Statement

1. We use cookies!

We use cookies on our website. A cookie is a small text file that will be stored on the hard drive of your device(s) like your computer or laptop, when you visit our website. The information that is stored in a cookie can be sent back to our server when you visit our website again. Some cookies will be deleted automatically when clients closes their browser, others may be placed permanently and can also be read out during the next visit to our website. We are using the following types of cookies:

- **Functional cookies:** we use the so-called functional cookies. These cookies allow us to recognize you as a client and to store your preferences, so that we will not have to ask you for your preferences again when you are visiting our website in the future. We also use functional cookies to improve our website, so that we can adapt our website at all times to the preferences of our clients.
- **Google Analytics:** we use Google Analytics to gain more insight into your use of our website. The information that we obtain by using Google Analytics, including the IP address of your computer, will be transferred to Google and stored on Google servers in the United States. For more information about Google's and Google Analytics privacy policy, we recommend you to read the information provided on the websites of Google and Google Analytics. It is possible that Google shares the collected information with third parties. This might be the case when Google is legally required to do so or when third parties process the personal data on Google's behalf.
- **Third Party cookies:** finally our website uses cookies that are placed by third parties, the so-called tracking cookies. These cookies are used for marketing purposes and allow third parties to gain information concerning the online surfing behavior of clients. Based on that information, targeted advertisements can be offered. TekMi has no access to- and control over the cookies that are used by these advertisers.

2. Social media

We have incorporated social media buttons on to our website that allow you to promote or share pages on social media such as Twitter, Facebook, LinkedIn, Google+ en GitHub. These social media buttons are implemented by a code, which is provided by the aforementioned social media companies,

and work with cookies. By clicking on the social media button, these cookies will be placed on your (mobile) device. To find out how these parties process personal data, we recommend reading the Privacy- and Cookie Statements on their websites.

3. Delete cookies

You can delete or block cookies by changing the settings of your browser. For more information about activating, deactivating and removing cookies, we recommend to read the instructions in your browser and/or use the Help-function of your browser. Please note that if you block cookies our website may not function properly.
